What We Do In Class

- ★ **Getting Started:** Class opens with the "Daily Directions." This includes the "Warm-up" assignment.
- ★ **Daily Lesson:** The teacher will present new or review information with the class. This is when we update journals with notes.
- ★ **Partner/Group Study:** Students will be grouped in order to collaborate and share ideas on the content.
- ★ **Independent Study:** The students will move toward practicing and mastering content independently.

Conduct Consequences

Entering the room?

- ★ Come prepared for class and ready to work. All mandatory supplies should be brought to class each day, unless you are instructed to do otherwise by the teacher. The following supplies should be **INSIDE pencil pouch**: pens, pencils, erasers, colored pencils, blunt scissors, glue sticks, fine-tip expo markers, small ruler, and a pack of post-it notes. The following supplies should be **INSIDE 1.5 inch BINDER** that is shared with other classes: lined college ruled paper, graph paper, and a pocket dividers. Please make sure one of the dividers is labeled MATH. This is where students will place any work returned. All work will be placed inside of binder and should be available at all times.
- ★ Enter the room quietly and calmly before the bell.
- ★ Go to your seat, unpack back pack, place back pack in area designated by teacher, and follow the "Daily Directions" given on the board: complete warm-up on next page of journal and record daily lesson and upcoming assignments in agenda.

Leaving your seat?

- ★ Ask the teacher to leave your seat.
- ★ Quietly raise your hand. If the teacher is talking to the class or another student, wait until they are finished.
- ★ Walk calmly and quietly to your destination. Do not distract others.

PENCILS!

- ★ Nobody is perfect, therefore, we **ONLY USE PENCILS** so mistakes can be erased and corrected. **SHOW ALL WORK!**
- ★ Credit will not be given for work done in PEN.
- ★ A red pen will be used for student grading only.

Eating and drinking in class?

- ★ The only drink permitted in class is a **CLEAR bottle of water - no aluminum cans are allowed.**
- ★ A small snack is permitted during snack time at 10am.
- ★ Water and food must be kept away from computer area.

Participation in Class?

- ★ Student participation is mandatory.
- ★ Students will be randomly called on to share their "Warm-up".
- ★ Respect teachers and classmates' ideas during group work.
- ★ Students are encouraged to ask for help whenever needed!!!
- ★ Raise your hand and wait to be called on.
- ★ Use the appropriate voice level.
- ★ If working in groups or pairs, please ask two peers before asking the teacher.

Computer Use?

- ★ Computer & Internet activity is for class work ONLY.
- ★ You are not permitted to access unauthorized websites (including listening to music) or change the programming of the computer or desktop.
- ★ You will be assigned to a computer and must only use that designated computer. (This signed document serves as the computer contract as well - computer usage will be monitored daily).

Guests in the classroom?

- ★ Respect all guests in our room. If someone walks in the room, they will address you if they need something.
- ★ Just smile and keep working. ☺

Dismissal?

- ★ When instructed by the teacher, retrieve your back pack, pack your things, and remain seated until dismissed by the teacher.
